

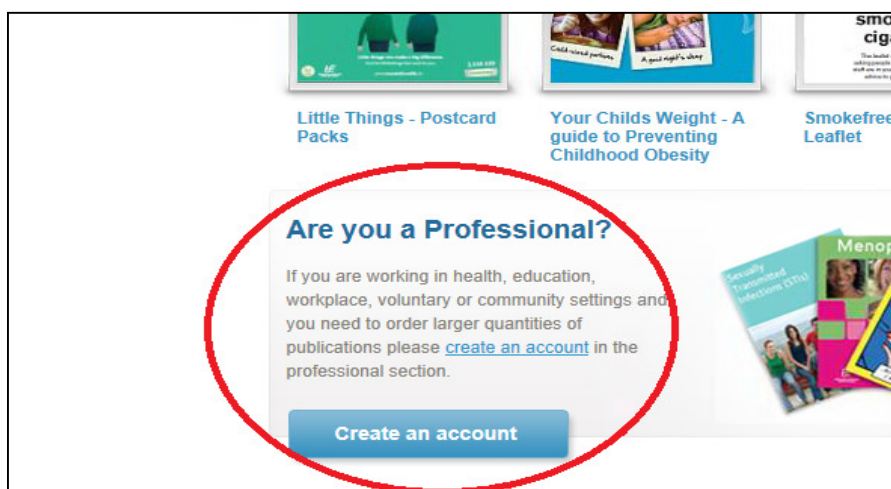
How to Register on www.healthpromotion.ie

There are two ways to order resources from the health promotion website, either as a member of the public or as a health professional. If you are a health professional registering will allow you order larger quantities of publications. Please follow the steps below:

1. Log on to <https://www.healthpromotion.ie/>
2. Click on [Order Publications](#) as circled below.



3. Click on [create an account](#) on the order publications page or click [register](#) in the professional section (below).



4. Once you click [register](#) fill in all of the contact information and press [send](#). You must give a valid phone number and e-mail address.
